

**FAIRMONT GIRLS BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION
PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. Players and parent(s)/guardian(s) have read and accept the Explanation of Expectations of the Fairmont girl's basketball association.
2. Players will attend practices, tournament games and abide by the Play Code of Conduct
3. Player Code of Conduct: (as a member of the Fairmont Girls Basketball Association Traveling Team, I will conduct myself according to the following precepts and rules.)
 - a. Players will conduct themselves in a sportsman like manner at all times, both on and off the court, whether winning or losing. This means
 - i. No Swearing or "trash talking:
 - ii. No criticizing fellow players or other teams
 - iii. No arguing with referees or coaches.
 - iv. No throwing of balls or equipment
 - v. No other inappropriate behavior while participating in Fairmont Girls Basketball Association events (such as fighting, vandalism, theft etc.) which discredits the Fairmont Girls Basketball Association, Fairmont Schools, Community, your parents and yourself.
 - b. Players will respect other teams and communities' equipment and facilities at all times.
 - c. Players will attend all practices and games unless ill, family event, church event, or academic event.
 - d. Players and parents agree to make Fairmont Girls Basketball Association their first (athletic) priority during the season.
 - e. Players will put aside personal differences during the Fairmont girl's basketball association season and work together as a team.
 - f. I as a player agree to be coach able and listen to my coaches and follow team rules
 - g. I will keep a positive attitude
 - h. I will do the best I can with my ability.
 - i. I understand that any bullying, name calling via text, face book, or any other electronic methods will not be tolerated.
4. Violations of the Player's Code of Conduct will directly affect playing time and participation. For violations i ii, iii, and iv the first offense will result in sitting out for two quarters of that game or the next. The second offense will be for an entire game. For Violations of number v the first offense will be for an entire game. The second offense will be for an entire tournament. For chronic violations (3 or More) could lead to suspension and/or expulsion form the Fairmont Girls Basketball Association Traveling Team. These are considered guidelines for the association, and depending on the severity of the episode the Board reserves the rite to not follow the above guidelines and take appropriate action.
